Public Access to the Wenrich Memorial Research Library

The Wenrich Library is a non-circulating reference library containing books, periodicals, photographs, slides and drawings, information on preservation techniques and The Landmark Society's extensive archives of local architecture. We have over 3,500 books, neighborhood surveys and clippings files with historic and architectural information, and much more!

Use of the Wenrich Memorial Research Library is by appointment only, usually during normal business hours.

We regret that we cannot accommodate “drop-in” visitors to the library.

- Please provide as much detail on your topic of interest as possible. For example, if it's a building, provide the address and any other information you have available.
- Our staff will determine if there is material in our library that may be of use to you, before contacting you to make a research appointment.
- Expect a wait of up to 5 days before you are contacted by the Education Associate.

Fees for the use of the Wenrich Memorial Research Library.

- Use of the library is complimentary for Landmark Society Members.
- Nonmembers may conduct research at a starting fee of \$10 per hour, per person.
- Research requiring ongoing staff assistance will be charged at a higher rate, based on hourly staff rates and other factors.

When you come for your research appointment.

- Please bring with you photo ID.
- We will ask you to provide a credit card number and sign a form, indicating you understand you will be charged for missing or damaged library materials.
- Plan on checking your coat, briefcase, backpack or other large carriers at our reception area before accessing the library.
